- Registration Fee of \$200.00.
- Pledge to become a 99 Club RPAC investor in 2023.

- Attend at least 2 PAR Luncheons.
- Attend at least 1 BOD meeting.
- Select and serve on at least 1 committee with no more than 2 excused absences.

- Participate in and complete a group project.
